



Students, school staff, and community should wear their blue shirt! • Is it bullying when someone says or does something unintentionally hurtful and they do it once? That’s RUDE! • Is it bullying when someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they do it once? That’s MEAN! • When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they keep doing it-even when you tell them to stop or show them that you’re upset? That’s BULLYING!
